



What is BTEC?

The BTEC (Business and Technology Education Council) Level 3 Extended Diploma is a Further Education and vocational qualification taken in England, Wales and Northern Ireland. The qualification is organized and awarded by Pearson within the BTEC brand and it is equivalent to A-Levels. Pearson is a global leader in education, working to help people of all ages make measurable progress in their lives by providing learning materials, technologies, assessment and services.

BTEC Assessment

BTEC courses give credits for work done as you go along. Assessment incorporates all work done within the 2 years of after which an overall grade at the end of the 2 years.

Modes of assessment vary according to the type and level of course you are on. Assessment can be through a variety of methods and will reflect what you have achieved during the course (diary notes, photographs, presentations, reports, video footage, etc).

A large proportion, if not all of the course, is internally assessed. Therefore, it is essential that you keep a portfolio of evidence of all of your achievements. This includes course work, such as; items, photographs, video footage, assignments, computer printouts, questionnaires, checklists, or projects, etc.

The evidence will demonstrate what you have learnt and will be looked at during moderation by your assessors.

BTEC qualifications have been developed to provide specialist work-related qualifications in a range of areas. The courses offered are practical and will give you the opportunity to complete assignments and activities based on realistic situations linked to working in a variety of related environments. There will be no formal examinations for this course.

Cambridge Lower Secondary includes two testing options:

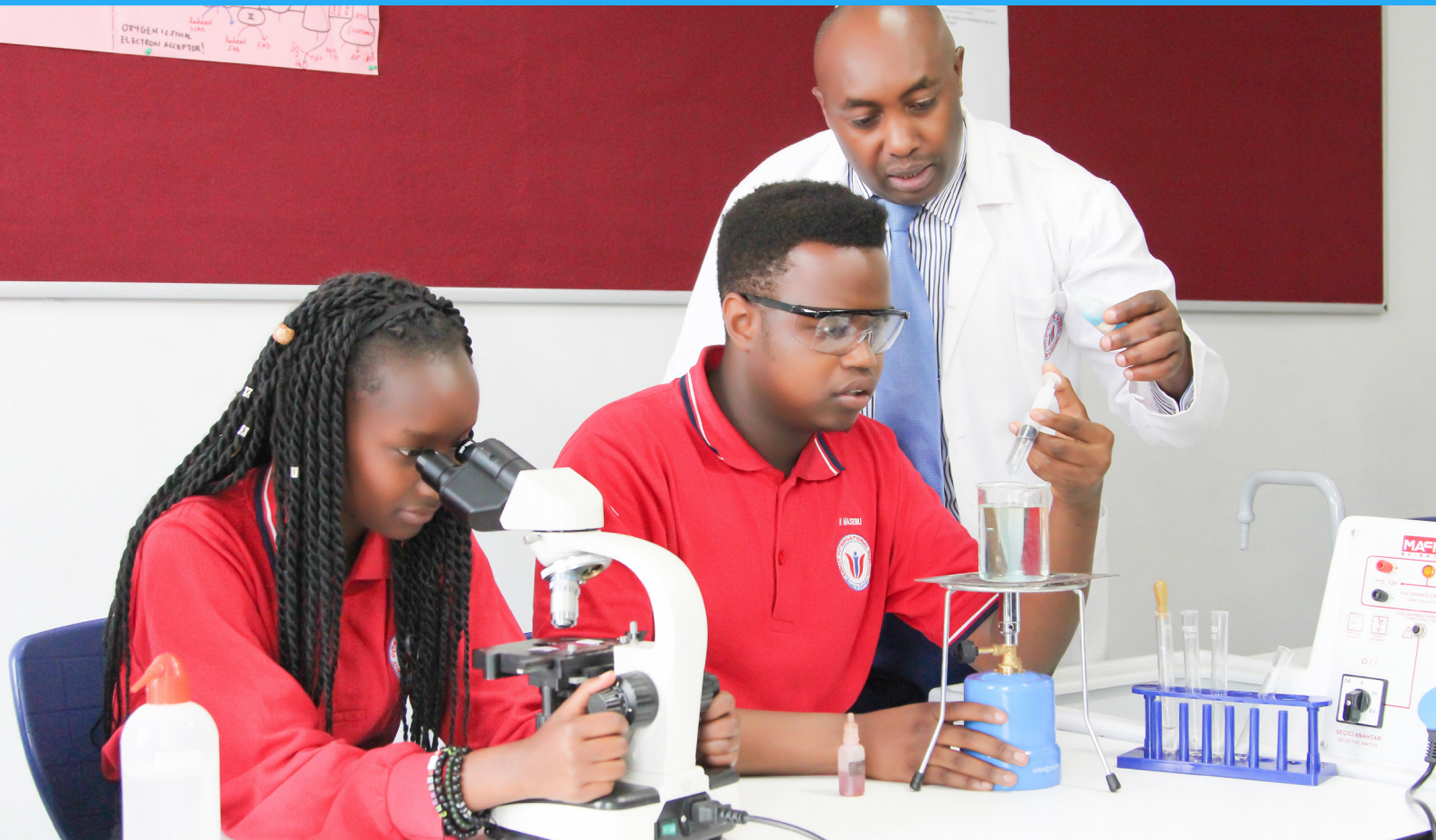
- Cambridge Lower Secondary Progression Tests and

These assessments provide an international reference of student achievement, helping teachers to identify learners' strengths and weaknesses and give advice on progression routes.

Our year 9 students sit for Cambridge Checkpoint examination once a year, in April and results published in June. The following subject areas are examined;

- English,
- Mathematics,
- Science and
- Global Perspective.

They are also assessed internally on a regular basis through a range of different methods including tests, coursework, homework, term papers and teacher observation just like years 7 and 8.

The International General Certificate of Secondary Education (IGCSE) is an English language curriculum offered to students to prepare them for International Baccalaureate, A Level and BTEC Level 3 (which is recommended for higher-tier students).
