SCHOOL FEE TERMS & CONDITIONS

1) All fee types must be paid in full at least fifteen days before the start of each term.

2) School fees are payable in Kenya Shillings only.

3) The school generates fee invoices annually and emails them to parents once a year before the academic year begins. Any additional fees (such as exams, trips, or activities) that may arise during the year will be added to the invoice.

4) A surcharge of 5% is levied per month on any fee balance a student may have.

5) Termly Fee Types are chargeable and payable over three terms for all classes, except Years 9, 11, 12, and 13, for which they chargeable and payable over two terms only (Term 1 and Term 2).

6) Dropping Boarding Service: To drop a student from the boarding service, a Drop Form must be completed and emailed to the school's official email address at least five weeks (35 days) before the start of the next term. A written acknowledgment from the Principal is required for the change to take effect. Without this approval, no changes will be applied. This option is available only for Term 1 and Term 2. Note: Dropping boarding for Term 3 will not be approved. The full boarding fee remains payable, and no refund, credit note, or reimbursement will be issued under any circumstances.

7) Lunch and boarding fees are subject to amendment within an academic year based on inflation and/or the cost of basic commodities.

8) The lunch fee is compulsory for all day students.

9) School and PE uniforms are not included in the fees. Please contact the receptionist for details.

10) Cambridge Examination Fees for candidate classes (Years 11, 12, and 13) must be paid by 30th January of the respective year. Exam registration will not proceed unless all outstanding school fee balances are fully cleared. For some classes, the applicability of modules, subjects, exams, and related fees may be determined or invoiced during the academic year, based on the practices

established by Cambridge Assessment International Education.

11) ICE Entry Fee Notice: Payment of the ICE entry fee does not guarantee issuance of an ICE Certificate. The certificate will only be awarded if the student meets the qualification criteria set by Cambridge Assessment International Education. If eligible, the certificate will be issued directly by Cambridge.

12) A written notice of at least five weeks (35 days) must be submitted to the school's official email address before the start of the next term, along with a written acknowledgment from the Principal, to formally withdraw a student from the school register. In the absence of such notice, a full term's fees will be payable in lieu.

13) The school reserves right of admission.

14) Commitment Fee for New Admissions: In certain year groups where vacancies are limited, an advance payment or commitment fee may be required as a condition for the admission of new students to reserve a place at the school. This fee may be equivalent to a minimum of 50% of the fee for the term in which the student is enrolling. If there are fewer than three weeks remaining before the start of the term, the full enrolment term fee must be paid upon registration. The commitment fee is non-refundable if the applicant withdraws or forfeits the placement opportunity. Students who cannot be accommodated immediately may be placed on a waiting list.

15) The school reserves the right to temporarily withhold access to classes, official documents, or school services if fee balances remain unpaid.

16) Sibling discount is applicable only on tuition fee for students who registered at Light Group of Schools and applicable as follows:

-1st born child is not entitled to a discount.

-2nd born child is entitled to a 5% discount.

-3rd born child is entitled to a 10% discount.

-4th born child and any other siblings after are entitled to a 15%.

-When one of the sibling graduates or transfers, the sibling discounts will be recalculated.
